My Life in HKMA



- Worked as a programmer with IT Application Support Team 2 (ITAS2)
- From 1 June 2004 to 25 July 2005
- ITAS2: 1 Manager, 4 System Analysts, 2 Placement Programmers
- responsible for providing supports to the whole banking department

Job Duties – Surveys Development



- Includes Credit Card Loans, Residential Mortgage Loans (RML), etc.
- Perform daily operations on survey uploading
- Develop programs for banking colleagues to generate public release reports
- From collecting requirements to UAT testing

Job Duties – Returns Development



- Includes Assets & Liabilities, Profit & Loss, Maturity Items, etc.
- Data from Returns is more significant and highly confidential
- Most impressive enhancement – Request on handling change in bank types
- Involved > 20 programs and > 10 views

Other Job Duties



- Effort Estimations to outsourced project
- Oracle Forms and Reports Development
- Support on Banking Policy Audit Project
- Documentations writing (e.g. Disaster Contingency Plan, banking logic reference, etc.)
